**Plane of the Month** - George Mellow presented a "slick 60" of his own design and John Banner showed a "Kaos". The Kaos won.

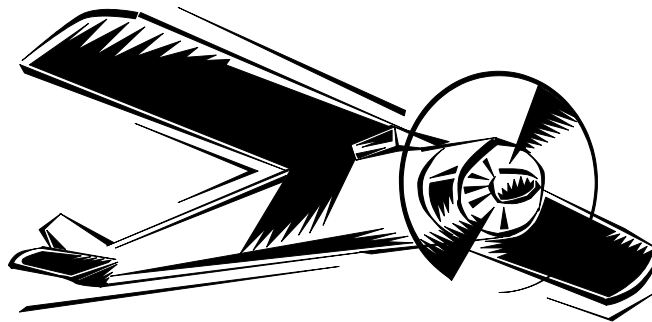
**8 Ball Award** - Again, Dee Miller wins for reversing his ailerons on his Something Extra resulting in damage.

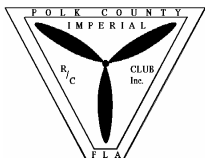
