Sportsman ship award given to David Kreitz for second time for his hard work on the flying field.

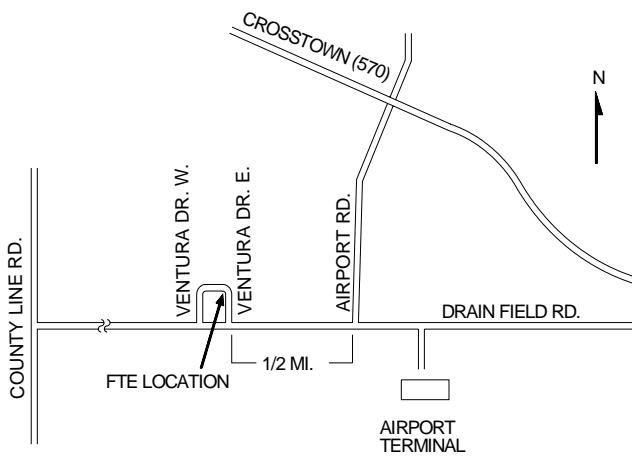

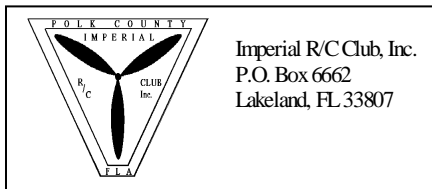
