But I just read an article on how the number of accidents greatly increases when temperatures start to soar. We have all been there, whether putting a plane together or taking it apart or trying to fix something. The sweat begins to flow, we begin wiping the sweat from our eyes and the story goes on. It is typical human nature when this happens to try to finish the task as quickly as possible! Well this is where mistakes and oversights happen and often times resulting in an accident. These accidents can be a minor scratch or much more severe such as putting a hand in a wide open prop! But no matter the severity of the injury, it should have not happened!

I have really worked on when I get that point to force myself to take a seat for 5 minutes. Have a water and chill for a minute. I also have found that these scarfs that swell up when put in water and then wrap around neck really cool it down. I think the Home Depot's and Lowes all carry them and they are pretty cheap. Give it a try, we have several months of these temps to come so be ready.
